# TERMS & CONDITIONS

***Dog safety is our priority, so please make sure all dogs arrive and leave the facility on lead.***

## **Hours and Payment Requirements**

Duke's Dog Daycare usual hours of operation are 7:00 am – 6:00 pm Monday through Friday. Drop off and pick up is any time during these hours. Duke's Dog Daycare is closed weekends and public holidays.

Late fees will be charged for picks ups after closing hours (\$10 every 15 minutes) If you are going to be late for pick up give us a call in this instance to let us know where you are so we can help if possible)

All services are to be paid for in advance (we accept bank transfer, cash or eftpos). Where a half day service has been requested but you are late for pick up, you may be charged the full day rate. (As above, please call us to let us know where you are so we can help if possible)

The security of your dog is very important to us therefore dogs will only be released to the owners or named contacts as listed on this form.

Where fees remain unpaid, these may be sent to collections, and as such you will be responsible for all collections and legal fees incurred by such actions taken.

## **Behaviour**

You acknowledge that Duke's Dog Daycare reserves the right to refuse admittance to your dog at any time if problems arise from their behaviour - any behaviour deemed dangerous or inappropriate by Duke's Dog Daycare or its staff may result in dismissal of your dog from the facility. We will always work with you first in this instance, with training advice and solutions wherever possible.

## **Health and Emergency Procedures**

By using our service, you acknowledge and understand that there are certain risks involved in participating in day care and that Duke's Dog Daycare or its staff will not be liable for any injuries or illnesses resulting during your dog's attendance. In the unlikely event that your dog is injured by another dog, you will not hold Duke's Dog Daycare or its staff responsible for the injury. If your dog injures another dog or person, you will be solely responsible for the injury. By using our services, you accept that you may be liable for any expenses occurred due to the actions of your dog including, but not limited to, medical expenses and damage to property.

In admitting your dog into Duke's Dog Daycare, you understand that the facility has relied on your representation that your dog is in good health, has not been ill with any communicable disease within the last 30 days and that they have been vaccinated as indicated by records presented. You also understand that it is your responsibility to provide on-going verification of current vaccinations. It is still possible for a dog to become ill, even if vaccinated. Duke's Dog Daycare reserves the right not to allow your dog into our facility if your dog looks sick, injured, or if we feel your dog requires professional medical care.

If any medical problems develop while your dog is in the care of Duke's Dog Daycare, you authorise Duke's Dog Daycare to do whatever they believe is necessary for the safety, health and well-being of your dog and you agree to pay all expenses incurred. If that happens, Duke's Dog Daycare will endeavour to contact you as soon as possible using the contact information you have provided.

You agree not to hold Duke's Dog Daycare or its staff liable for any decisions they make and you shall be responsible for all costs incurred with the care of your dog which includes, but is not limited to, emergency veterinary care.

If we are unable to contact you or you refuse medical treatment for your dog, Duke's Dog Daycare, at its sole discretion, may engage the services of a veterinarian and/or administer medicine to make your pet as comfortable as possible until picked up by you, and you hereby authorise us to provide any such service at your expense.

## **General**

Dogs not regularly exposed to the level of activity at Duke's Dog Daycare may feel the discomfort of sore muscles, sore joints and fatigue.

Dogs playing at dog day care can at times get dirty, especially dogs with longer fur, from the level of activity at daycare.

In the unlikely event your dog is abandoned as defined by local Council law, we will make every attempt to contact the owners and emergency contacts and your listed veterinarian. If your dog is not picked up within 7 days of the expected pick up date, your dog may be given up for adoption.

Photographs or digital recordings are taken of the dogs, customers and staff on a regular basis. You acknowledge that all such images and the copyrights therein, are the property of Duke's Dog Daycare. If you would like a copy of these images please contact us. You agree for any images to be used on our social media platforms and on our website.

You agree that your dog is registered with the local Council and you will continue to keep the registrations up to date, you have disclosed to Duke's Dog Daycare all relevant information regarding your dog's history and understand it is your responsibility to keep Duke's Dog Daycare informed of any changes to your dog's behaviour or health in the future.

You waive all claims against Duke's Dog Daycare and its employees and representatives, except those arising from negligence on the part of Duke's Dog Daycare.

These terms do not limit any liability of Duke's Dog Daycare under the Consumer Guarantees Act.
